**ISSUE**

The purpose of this agenda item is to give the public safety committee an update on police department operations.

**SUMMARY**

All positions at the Stanwood Police Department are fully staffed at this time. At the end of 2018, the department celebrated the retirements of SRO Shane Jensen (the longest serving SRO in the state at the time of retirement), Dep. Greg Rasar (30 year veteran), and our front office records technician, Peg Girard. Their replacements are in place and doing a great job. We continued to see a dramatic drop in crime in the City of Stanwood in 2018. During the mayor's annual state of the city address to the chamber of commerce, the city had experienced a 26% decrease in burglaries, a 33% decrease in vehicle thefts, and a 31% decrease in thefts. Many of those trends are continuing in 2019 as well. On the civilian side of the house, we continue to see an increase in workload. Records staff experienced an 11% increase in public disclosure requests and a 25% increase in both concealed gun permit applications and fingerprint applications.
